POLICE REPORT

McBride R.C.M.P. and the B.C. Coroner's service continue to investigate the fatal motor vehicle accident of Norman Massicotte, Age 58, of Prince George, B.C. Massicotte was operating a Loaded B-Train when it left Hwy. 16 app. 97 kms west of McBride, B.C. on Tuesday Evening at App. 6:40 P.M.

Dec. 17, 2004 - RCMP received a report of a single vehicle incident on Hwy. 16 near Slim Creek. The occupants of a blue Toyota pickup did not suffer any injuries although the vehicle was in the ditch. The vehicle was towed to Prince George.

Dec. 17, 2004 - A report was received of an alarm at a local service station. The owner of the business attended the property and the alarm was cancelled as there was no suspicious activities.

Dec. 17 2004 - RCMP received a report of an injured calf moose lying in the ditch on Eddy Road. A cow moose was hanging around the area creating a potential hazard on the road. Clearwater Conservation was contacted and the calf moose was taken care of.

Dec. 19, 2004 - A report was received of a single vehicle crash on Highway 16 west of Loos. RCMP attended and it was found that the pickup hauling a trailer with 4 sleds was stolen out of Valemount previously. The vehicles were recovered and returned to the owner who resides in Edmonton. There were no suspects or witnesses at the scene of the incident.

Dec. 20, 2004 - RCMP were alerted to a possible single vehicle crash on Highway 16 west of McBride near Goat River. The information received is that there were possibly a driver and occupants trapped inside their vehicle as the snow in the ditch would not allow the doors to open. Patrols were made but the vehicle was not located. It is possible that the vehicle had already been towed prior to police attendance.

Dec. 20, 2004 - A report was received of a single vehicle crash on Highway 16 west of McBride near LeGrand. The driver was west bound when he lost control of the vehicle on slushy road conditions causing the vehicle to hit the ditch. The driver sustained a minor cut to the hand. The vehicle is irreparable.

Dec. 21, 2004 - RCMP were alerted to a possible impaired driver within the village limits. Patrols were made and the driver was located in a private residence. Due to the strong smell of alcohol and information received, the driver was served with a 24 hour notice of suspension.

Dec. 21, 2004 - An incident involving a pickup truck and a moose was reported 15 km east of McBride on Highway 16. The moose came out of the ditch and the vehicle travelling west hit head on and then went into the ditch. The vehicle suffered severe damage and unfortunately the moose had to be disposed of.

Dec. 22, 2004 - RCMP received a report of a single vehicle crash the night before near the Dome Creek Bridge West of McBride on Highway 16. The driver sustained minor injuries and was transported to Prince George Regional Hospital by another motorist. Even though the driver had a seatbelt exemption from her doctor, she was still wearing her seatbelt, which contributed to saving her life. The vehicle was located the next day down a very steep embankment.

Dec. 23, 2004 - A 9-1-1 call was received through the Prince George Dispatch center at a residence on Mountainview Road. The caller stated that they were making a prank call. RCMP attended the residence and warned the youth on the charges of public mischief. Dec. 24, 2004 - A report of a dark pickup in the ditch at 1st Ave. and Dominion street was made in the early hours. Patrols were made and the vehicle was not located. This matter is currently under investigation.

The remainder of the calls were of general nature and routine in service.
