POLICE REPORT

Jan. 08, 2005 - An old sword was turned into the RCMP as found property. The owner can claim the item by identifying at the McBride Detachment.

Jan. 10, 2005 - RCMP were called to a suspicious occurrence on 3rd Ave. in the late morning hours. Patrols were made and the subject was located. Investigation revealed that everything was okay and there was no criminal activity that had taken place.

Jan. 10, 2005 - A report was received of a single vehicle incident on Highway 16 and Zeidler Drive intersection. A logging truck was making a right turn on an icy corner and the cab slid partially into the ditch with the deck still on Zeidler road. There were no injuries and the vehicle was soon back on its way.

Jan. 10, 2005 - A complaint was received that someone had left some avalanche safety equipment at the Renshaw parking lot and cabin. If anyone has retrieved any items from this area since Jan. 07, 2005 please bring it to the McBride RCMP.

Jan. 11, 2005 - A two vehicle crash on Highway 16, 50 Km west of McBride was reported in the early evening. The driver was travelling eastbound and following a semi truck and trailer. There was thick blowing snow behind the unit and the driver of a Chevy Cavalier rear ended the semi. The driver of the car was transported to hospital with minor injuries and was issued a Violation Ticket for following too close.

Jan. 12, 2005 - While on routine patrol, RCMP came across a single vehicle roll over 1.6 km East of the Holmes River on Highway 16. The owner of the vehicle has yet to report the incident to the RCMP.

Jan. 12, 2005 - Another report of a single vehicle crash was reported this time on Highway 16 West of McBride near Dorval Road. The driver of a red Hyundai was travelling eastbound and came over the crest of a hill noticing a white out of snow ahead. The driver noticed the flashing lights of a grader a little too late and ended up driving into the south ditch to avoid a collision. There were no injuries in this incident.

Jan. 12, 2005 - A report of a single vehicle crash with a moose was reported on Highway 16 West of McBride near the Goat River Forest Service Road. There were no injuries and damage to the vehicle was minimal.

Jan. 13, 2005 - While on routine patrol, a vehicle was pulled over and open liquor was located in the vehicle. The driver was issued a warning.

Jan. 13, 2005 - A report was received of a pitbull wandering around the 5th Ave. neighbourhood. The dog was seized and returned to the owner.

The RCMP would like to remind motorists to travel at a safe distance behind other vehicles and to be a little more diligent when travelling on the Highway as there is a lot of traffic as well as Plow trucks and Graders working on the road surface.
