## MENTAL HEALTH WEEK

May 2 - 8 is Mental Health Week - NIRMHAAC is the mental Health and Addictions Advisory Committee of the Northern Interior Region. (Robson Valley, Mackenzie, Burns Lake, Quesnel, Prince George). Consumers, family members and care providers join with representatives from various mental health agencies at meetings which take place five times a year in Prince George. Committee members can obtain information for residents and bring up their concerns at the meetings. NIRMHAAC is one of only a few Mental Health Advisory Committees still in existence.

## POLICE REPORT

On April 29th 2005 at 3:50 p.m. the McBride Detachment of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police was notified of a snowmobile accident occurring on a glacier on the Dore River Drainage southwest of the Village of McBride. The preliminary information received was that a 31 year old male from the Edmonton Alberta area had been snowmobiling on the glacier when his machine struck a crevasse, the male then fell off of his machine and fell into the crevasse. The British Columbia Ambulance Service and the local Search and Rescue were also dispatched. It was decided by Search and Rescue to enlist the assistance of the Jasper National Park of Canada Wardens who have the specialized training to respond to these types of rescue / recovery. The National Park Wardens were airlifted from Jasper by a helicopter from Valemont and flown directly to the scene. Once at the scene a Park Warden was lowered into the crevasse which was approximately 5 feet by 10 feet, the victim had fallen approximately 25 meters into the crevasse. The victim was brought out of the crevasse and was pronounced dead at the scene by a Paramedic. The British Columbia Coroner's Service from Prince George, along with the assistance of the McBride Detachment of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police are continuing the investigation into this sudden death. The name of the victim will not be released at this time as further next of kin notifications are being completed.
