## POLICE REPORT

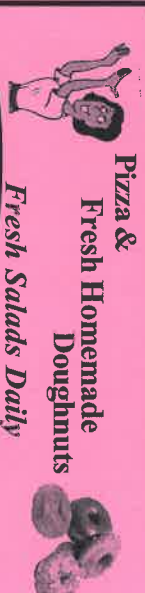
