SOAP BOX RACES

I am currently working with the Elks / Royal Purple of McBride to put on Soap Box Races for the kids during the 2005 Pioneer days event. There is a lot of work to be done to build two cars and a ramp system for these races. I strongly believe more needs to be done for the children and younger generations of the valley and that is why I am working on putting this event together. I am calling upon businesses and individuals to come forward and donate material, time and shop space to assist in making this event a reality. The idea is to provide two cars for this year's event in hopes that future events will inspire individuals to spend quality bonding time with their children to fabricate their own custom cars built to their likings! By providing the cars, it will give them an opportunity to take part in this event without spending time and money only to find they are not really interested. I am sure it will take off like wild fire once they become involved. I have information with the specifications for the actual cars, however, because this is a local event and is not sanctioned by any outside agency or body, we are at liberty to set the standards for the cars. Basically, they are non-motorized lightweight cars that are propelled by the force of gravity down an inclined ramp. The plans are very detailed and are contained in a 64 page booklet. I have included the web-site where these plans can be downloaded from. For this years event I am proposing using two old go carts without motors so that the level of interest can be gauged. The idea of this event is again, to provide entertainment and opportunities for the younger generations to take part in. There would be a minimal entrance fee charged to cover prizes for the participants in the event. The idea is to make it affordable and available to all children of the valley. These races would be open to both boys and girls and to any age so long as they were able to steer the car and be able to apply the brakes. If you are interested in assisting or can provide the much needed resources, please contact me a.s.a.p.! I have generated a list of the materials needed, it may be altered as time goes on and other materials are required. I thank you in advance for your time and assistance in helping to make this event a reality. A few generous individuals and businesses have already come forward and donated or offered the use of items and materials. We have a flat deck trailer to be used to set the ramp up on, it needs new decking as the existing deck is rotted out and unsafe. Materials and volunteers are required to resurface the deck as well as to construct the ramp. A location is also needed to perform this work, ideally with power and possibly a wire welder. I look forward to seeing these races happen and to seeing a lot of participants.
