POLICE REPORT

On June 19th, at 5:30 A.M., members from the McBride Detachment, along with personnel from the BC Ambulance Service, McBride Volunteer Fire Department, and the BC Coroners Service, attended to a fatal motor vehicle incident on Highway 16 near the Ptarmigan Creek Bridge, at Dome Creek. An eastbound B-Train, fully loaded with wood, drove off the road to the left as it descended down the sharp curve in a steep incline. As a result of the crash, the 43 year old male driver was found deceased when emergency services personnel arrived. A scene examination was conducted by an RCMP Collision Reconstructionist from Prince George. Investigation into this crash continues in conjunction with the BC Coroners Service and Workers Compensation Board. The name of the driver has not been released until next of kin have been notified.
