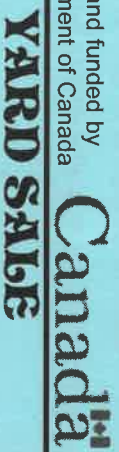

POLICE REPORT

On June 4th, 2005 at approximately 4:38 PM, RCMP members from the McBride Detachment, along with personnel from the BC Ambulance Service, BC Coroners Service, and the McBride Volunteer Fire Department, responded to a fatal motor vehicle collision that occurred approximately five kilometres west of McBride on Hwy. 16 near the intersection of Dyke Road. Due to the magnitude of this unfortunate incident, RCMP members from North District Traffic Services including a Collision Reconstructionist, and the nearby Valmont Detachment attended to assist with the investigation. It appears from the preliminary investigation that a blue and grey Dodge extended cab pickup truck was travelling west from Terrace, British Columbia to Calgary, Alberta. The pickup truck suddenly crossed over the center line of the highway into the opposite lane where it collided head on with a tractor-trailer unit heading west from Edson, Alberta to Kinmat, British Columbia. The driver of the tractor-trailer unit sustained only minor injuries. The investigation has revealed that the driver of the tractor-trailer unit had attempted to avoid the collision by pulling his unit as far right in his lane as possible. The occupants of the pickup were pronounced dead at the scene. The driver of the pickup was a 72 year old male from Terrace, British Columbia. The other two occupants of the pickup, a 27 year old female along with her 4 month old baby daughter, were from Calgary. Names of the deceased are being withheld until next of kin have been notified. The investigation is continuing and investigators are attempting to determine why the pickup was travelling in the wrong lane. Anyone with any information regarding this collision is asked to contact the McBride Detachment of the RCMP at (250)569-2255. The RCMP would be interested in speaking with anyone who may have observed these vehicles prior to the collision.

May 28, 2005 - A member on patrol pulled over a vehicle for speeding. The member smelt liquor on the breath of the driver. A road side screening demand was read and the driver registered a "warn". The driver was issued a 24 hour Driving Prohibition and his vehicle was impounded for 24 hours.

May 28, 2005 - A member at a road check noticed open alcohol behind the driver's seat. The driver was given a verbal warning and the liquor was seized and destroyed under the Liquor Control and Licensing Act.

May 28, 2005 - A member at a road check smelt Marijuana inside a vehicle. The occupants were arrested and chartered. A search of the vehicle revealed a small amount of Marijuana. The Marijuana was seized under the Controlled Drugs and Substance Act and the occupants were given a verbal warning regarding possession of a controlled substance.

May 28, 2005 - Members responded to a residence where an individual barged in and assaulted two individuals, alcohol was involved. The victims of the incident did not want to pursue charges, a verbal warning was issued to the suspect.

May 29, 2005 - A vehicle was pulled over for speeding and the member smelt Marijuana. The occupants were arrested and chartered. A search of the vehicle revealed a small amount of Marijuana. The Marijuana was seized under the Controlled Drugs and Substance Act and the occupants were given a verbal warning regarding possession of a controlled substance.

May 31, 2005 - McBride Detachment received a report of a stranded motorist on the Holmes River FSR caught on the other side of a washout. Investigation revealed that the vehicle was stolen out of Alberta. The vehicle was recovered and turned over to the owner. The subject was arrested and faces charges out of Alberta relating to the incident.
