Village of McBride - Hydrant and Water Line Flushing Program - July 25th - Aug. 26th / 05. The village of McBride has recently reconfigured the water delivery system in order to reduce the amount of sand and silt entering the water delivery lines. This work must now be followed by a complete flushing of the water lines and hydrants. This program will take place from July 25 - Aug. 26 / 05 inclusive, between 4 am. and 10 am. each day. Residents and businesses may notice some discoloured water during the flushing time and machines such as washers should not be used during this time. We ask that all residents and businesses bear with us, as we complete this program. We believe that at the completion of the program residents and businesses will notice substantially better water quality on a permanent basis.

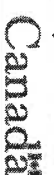
