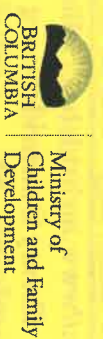

### POLICE REPORT

July 16, 2005 - Report of a disturbance was received, member attended and settled dispute between the two individuals.  
July 18, 2005 - Report of an abandoned 911 call, member attended and confirmed that it was a false alarm.  
July 19, 2005 - Call received of a black bear hanging around a residence on Sanson Road.  
July 19, 2005 - A motorist reported hitting a Deer approximately 3km's West of McBride on Highway 16. There were no injuries.  
July 20, 2005 - A report was received of an abandoned vehicle on the Holmes River Forest Service Road. A patrol was made and found that the vehicle was not abandoned.  
July 20, 2005 - A report was received of a black bear running around behind Dominion Crescent. Patrol made but there was no sign of the bear.  
July 20, 2005 - A report was received of a single vehicle roll over with 5 occupants approximately 17 km West of McBride on Highway 16. All five occupants were transported to McBride Hospital by BC Ambulance with non life threatening injuries.  
On July 24th, McBride RCMP attended to the Loos Road area in Crescent Spur where a private residence was broken into sometime during the past week. Investigation revealed that the suspects initially cut the telephone line leading to the residence and then forced their way inside by prying the lock from the door frame. Forced entry was also gained into a locked storage shed. Once inside, the suspects then rummaged through the contents taking a large quantity of high valued items. The items included one Ruger 300 Winchester Magnum bolt action rifle, one 12 gauge Ithaca pump action shotgun, various carpentry tools, storage trunks, jewelry and sports equipment. The scene was further examined by a member with the RCMP Forensic Identification Section from Prince George. Investigation continues and anyone with information regarding this incident is asked to contact the McBride Detachment at (250)566-2255 or Crime Stoppers at (800)222-TIPS.
