POLICE REPORT

McBride Detachment received a tip from a local resident that three young men were acting suspiciously at a local business. The complainant had the forethought to jot down the licence plate of the vehicle that the youths were occupying. The complainant provided the plate number to the Detachment which when ran on the police computer came up as unattached which is further indication of something very suspicious. The complainant also was very helpful to the police by watching the direction that the vehicle travelled when leaving the village of McBride and providing that information to the Detachment clerk. A McBride Detachment member was on patrol west of McBride on Hwy. 16 near the Scarecrow Inn when the call came. The member began patrolling east back into McBride when he came upon the suspicious vehicle travelling westbound. The McBride member pulled in behind the suspicious vehicle, passed it to get in front, and waited for the second McBride Detachment member to arrive so that the vehicle was boxed in between two police units. The driver of the suspicious vehicle, sensing the police presence, decided to turn off the highway onto Clyde Pit Road. The suspicious vehicle was followed by the two McBride police vehicle. The suspicious vehicle spun out on the icy roads and the three occupants were apprehended without incident. The vehicle and the licence plate were both stolen from Mission 5 days previous. The driver, a 17 year old Lower Mainland resident, was held in custody and transported to Prince George to appear in Provincial Court on Tuesday morning. The other youth from Prince George and an Adult from the Lower Mainland were released to appear in Court in McBride at a later date. McBride Detachment along with the victims would like to pass on their appreciation to the McBride resident who provided the information that led to the recovery of stolen property and the arrest of the three responsible, great work, thank you!!!!

After lodging the youth in Prince George City Cells the McBride Detachment member was in the process of leaving the City of Prince George when the officer noted a vehicle driving erratically. The member pulled the vehicle over and noted an odor of liquor on the breath of the driver. The member read the Road Side Screen Device Demand to the driver who blew a warning on the Alco Sensor. The driver was issued a 24 hour suspension.

The McBride Detachment member then was gassing up the police vehicle when he noticed a couple of suspicious people outside of a gas station on Queensway in Prince George. The member investigated and noticed opened liquor inside the couples' pickup truck. The member searched the vehicle under the Liquor Control and Licensing Act and located a loaded .22 calibre hand gun inside the vehicle along with some cocaine and heroin. Both occupants were arrested and will be facing weapons charges.
