

**POLICE REPORT**

During the morning of November 1st, just after 9:00 a.m., RCMP from the McBride Detachment were alerted to a suspicious occurrence where two males, associated to a newer model Ford pickup, pulled into the gas pumps at the local Husky Service Station. Witnesses reported that the two males were enquiring with staff at the Husky whether they could sell or exchange cartons of cigarettes for gasoline. Cst. KRZYZANOWSKI coincidentally happened to be in the immediate area and was alerted to this strange matter by a local resident. The pickup along with the two males was found at the Husky, however the vehicle immediately drove away at the sight of the police. Surprisingly, the pickup crossed the highway and drove directly over to the Chevron Service Station gas pumps. In the meantime, the pickup bearing an Alberta license plate was determined to have been stolen from the Kelowna area. Both males were subsequently arrested by the lone officer without incident. Cst. BENDSEN also attended the scene to assist by seizing the stolen vehicle. A subsequent search of the vehicle resulted in the discovery of a large quantity of Player's and Du Maurier cigarette cartons and illicit drug paraphernalia. Enquiries with the neighbouring RCMP Detachment revealed that members from Hinton responded to a break and enter investigation at a convenience store around 2:30a.m. this same day where nearly \$4000 worth of cigarette cartons were stolen. Thanks to the residents of McBride, they were able to assist in the apprehension of two criminals and recovery of over 30,000 worth of stolen property. Both adults male were from Calgary and they were later escorted to Prince George where they appeared in Provincial Court the following day. Investigation continues regarding this incident.

During the afternoon of November 6th, RCMP from the McBride Detachment responded to a break and enter complaint at a rural residence situated along Hinkelman Road. Residents at this location returned home to discover that somebody forcibly gained entry into their basement where a red M100 moto tiller, air compressor, and assorted air and electric power tools were stolen. The total value of the property stolen was estimated at over \$2000. This matter is still under investigation. Residents of McBride have recently been plagued by a rash of these incidents and anyone with info is asked to contact the detachment at 569-2255 or Crime Stoppers at (800)222-TIPS.
