POLICE REPORT

On Saturday February 4th 2006 at 3:36 PM McBride Detachment of the RCMP were contacted by the BC Ambulance Service reporting that they had received a call of an injured male. BC Ambulance advised that the male had fallen off a cliff while riding a snowmobile up Tommy Creek between the Renshaw and Chalco Mountains approximately 25 kilometres northeast of the Village of McBride. The McBride Search and Rescue Team and PEP were notified. A witness to the accident attended the McBride Detachment and provided directions on how to access the area. A Search Team assembled and attempted to access the area at night. Weather, the time of day, the area, and snow conditions proved to be too dangerous and the team was forced to turn around. Sunday morning weather conditions improved enough to allow a helicopter to gain access to the area. The Wardens from Jasper National Park attended to the area by helicopter and were able to use a heli-sling evacuation to rescue the injured man.

The 32 year old male hales from Slave Lake, Alberta, and was transported to the McBride and District Hospital where he was stabilized and then transported to Hinon, Alberta for further treatment for a broken leg. The male was extremely lucky to, not only survive the initial fall, but to be properly equipped to spend the night in the elements. The male had a packsack that included a tarp that kept him dry, warm, and protected from the strong winds that had whipped up on Saturday night.

This incident serves as a reminder to those who venture into the back country that the terrain and elements can be unforgiving and that people should be properly trained and equipped to deal with emergency situations as they occur. Daylight, weather, snow conditions, and terrain can hamper any efforts to rescue individuals that are injured in remote locations. Satellite telephones and utilizing GPS technology can speed up rescue efforts. The bottom line is be prepared and be patient as the safety of rescue personnel is equally important, and that safety concern can also delay any rescue attempt.

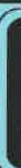
