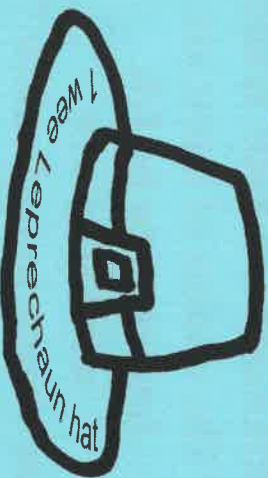

HAVE YOU TALKED TO YOUR KIDS!!!

Have you talked to your kids about Sex? Statistics Canada reported recently that 12 percent of boys and 13 percent of girls have had sex by the ages of 14 or 15. While statistics on sexual behaviour of teens in Prince George are not available, teens are being educated about sexual health to help them make healthy decisions.

It is important to provide information to young people as they progress through puberty and sexual maturity to help them make healthy choices in relationships and behaviour. It is a myth that the more a teen knows about sex the more they will experiment. They need to know about their bodies and how to stay healthy as they are faced with changing relationships and pressures.

Parents are the primary educators for their children whether by example or through discussion. By avoiding the subject you are actually sending the message that the topic of sex is off limits. So where will the information come from and will it be accurate or reflect your family's values?

From the onset of puberty, boys and girls experience physical, emotional and social changes. At the elementary school level, family life is part of the curriculum and includes puberty, hygiene, healthy relationships, and reproduction. At the high school level, sexuality is discussed and students are given information about abstinence, relationships, contraception, and sexually transmitted infections. The nurses are a valuable resource for teachers providing classroom instruction, resources, and individual student counselling.
