Some on-call and after-hours work is involved. The successful candidate will also be required to complete an RCMP security clearance. 10-14 hours/week maximum, some after hours.

## POLICE REPORT

May 12, 2006 - While on routine patrol a vehicle had previously been at the liquor store. Three open cans of beer were located inside the vehicle. The remaining liquor was seized and the driver was issued a violation ticket for open liquor in a vehicle. Steroids were also seized from the vehicle and have been sent for analysis to the RCMP Lab.

May 12, 2006 - In the late evening a vehicle was checked after leaving the local bar. The driver admitted to purchasing beer for an underage person. The liquor was seized and a warning was issued. May 14, 2006 - A report was received of a general intrusion alarm at a local establishment on main street. There was no sign of forced entry and the building was secure.

May 15, 2006 - The RCMP responded to a complaint of a suspicious male 30 km west of McBride on Highway 16 who had his vehicle parked facing the wrong way on the roadside. Immediate patrols were made to the area where an adult male from Vancouver was found to be slightly disoriented after smoking several marijuana joints prior to police locating him. A small quantity of marijuana was also found inside the vehicle and as a result of this investigation, the driver was issued a 24 hour roadside suspension along with impoundment of his vehicle. The male, who was cooperative at the time, was escorted back to McBride where he was later reported to be causing a disturbance in the downtown core. The same male was subsequently arrested under the Mental Health Act after he made comments to the police that he had microchips implanted in his body and a military special forces unit was allegedly looking to kill him. The male, who became extremely paranoid and agitated towards the police, was transported to the McBride and District Hospital where he was examined by a physician. He was subsequently transferred to Prince George Regional Hospital to undergo a psychiatric assessment. May 15, 2006 - A report was received of a single vehicle accident involving a deer on Mountainview Road. The driver was travelling west bound when a deer came out of the ditch and collided with the truck. There were no injuries and minor damage was estimated to the vehicle.

May 16, 2006 - RCMP, along with members from the Forestry Service, responded to a forest fire in the 9000 block of Highway 16 near Dunster. The fire, which threatened two residences in the area, appeared to have been caused by lightning. With the assistance of the Forestry Service along with many residence of Dunster and McBride, the fire was contained.

May 16, 2006 - An alarm was triggered at a local establishment in McBride due to the power outage. The premises were secure and there was no signs of forced entry.

May 16, 2006 - Another alarm was reported due to the power outage from earlier. There was no sign of forced entry and the premises was secure.

\*\*The RCMP have noticed an increase of erratic drivers, excessive speeding and motor vehicle incidents involving wild animals. We would like to remind motorists that summer holiday traffic has started and the animals are out in full force. Please obey the posted speed and drive safely.

On January 28th, 2005 at approximately 7pm, a McBride Detachment member pulled over a vehicle for speeding just east of Dunster on Hwy 16. The member noted a strong odor of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. The driver was arrested for possession of a controlled substance. The vehicle was searched under provisions of the Controlled Drug and Substances Act, the officer recovered approximately 1.7 Kilograms of Marijuana. The driver was released on a Promise to Appear and was later charged with one count of Possession of a Controlled Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking. On March 15th, 2006, in Canmore, Alberta, Jonathan SEGUN, pled guilty to the lesser and included offence of Possession of a Controlled Substance and received a fine of \$7,500.
