Susan Demaine of McBride, British Columbia, died on August 11, 2006, after a courageous battle with cancer. Born in Norfolk Virginia May 9, 1943, Sue grew up in Lynn and Swampscott Massachusetts and graduated from Swampscott High School. She received a B. A. in English Literature at Tufts University and earned a Masters degree in Library Science at Simmons College. After marrying Martin Demaine in 1966, they settled in New Brunswick and created the Opus Craft Village. Sue started out as a candle maker. She developed a unique wax formula that made the wax pliable and as a result she was able to make braided candles. Sue sold the candle business and opened a weaving studio. She wove garments, blankets, wall hangings and art pieces using all natural fiber that she dyed using plants and lichens that she gathered herself. Sue divorced Martin and soon after met Peter Alan who has been her husband, partner and soul mate for the last 30 years. In 1983 Sue and Peter moved to British Columbia and lived on Peter's trampoline for the next 4 years. In 1987 Sue started to work at the University of British Columbia and became Administrator of the Intranural Sports Program, a position she held for 16 years. Sue retired in 2003 and moved to McBride where she and Peter fulfilled their dream of living in a small community surrounded by mountains and wilderness. Susan's interests included gardening, hunting, trapping, fishing, weaving, herbolgy, and community development. Sue was predeceased by her father Frederick Russell. She leaves her husband and partner Peter, her mother Marjorie Russell, her sister Cynthia and her husband Hugo, her step-daughter Danielle, two step-grandchildren Cassidy and Robin, two nieces Dawn and Erica, and several aunts, uncles and cousins.
