POIGIE REPORT

On Friday September 8th, 2006 at 11:35pm. McBride Detachment responded to a fight in progress at a residence on 2nd Ave. BC Ambulance also attended on a report of a injured male. McBride RCMP Detachment members arrived and learned that 2 males from a crew working temporarily in the McBride area had been at a house party, became intoxicated and damaged the home. The home owner ejected the males from the party and a fight ensued outside of the residence. The 2 males left the area and later returned with reinforcements from their crew. Further altercations prior to and subsequent to the police arrival to the scene. McBride RCMP Detachment members arrested 5 individuals for Causing a Disturbance by Fighting and for Being Drunk in a Public Place under the Liquor Control and Licensing Act. Two of the five individuals were under the age of 18 and all were lodged in cells. A large number of the individuals that had been at the Party were under the age of 19 and were under the influence of liquor. The injuries to those involved were minor in nature with none of the injuries being admitted into the hospital. The incident was no doubt fuelled by alcohol and the incident could have been prevented with an early call to the police advising of an unwanted house guest. The reluctance to call the police earlier was probably due to the fact a large number of those in attendance at the party were under the age of 19. The investigation is continuing.

CHAMPION

Western Canadian Champion at Highland Games: On Saturday, September 2nd, 2006, former McBride resident, Duane McClinton competed in the Western Canadian Highland Games Championships in Calgary. He competes in the amateur B division and I believe there were 9 competitors. Carolyn (his wife) and Allisdair 2 and Lochlan 1 were there to cheer Daddy on, and of course, I was there too. Duane had an amazing day and we are all very proud of him. *The first event was Putting. The Braemore (heavy) stone weighing 22 pounds. Duane got 2nd in this event with a 26 foot 1 inch throw. The guys threw 16-pound hammer. Duane did well in this event bettering his distance with each throw. Final throw of 99.2 feet for first place. *Third event was the Spherical Metal Ball attached to a chain and ring. Duane threw his best at 26.2 feet and came in first. Next event Duane got 3rd with the Weight over the bar. This is an ordinary box weight with a ring attached, thrown over the bar from a standing position. Stone Throw. The 16 lb. open stone was his next event and he got 1st with a 36.9 foot throw. They then went on to the Caber, which is a very tough event of brawn and technique. The Calgary caber was 19.6 feet long and 95 lbs. Duane flipped this for an 11 o'clock win. Two more events - First was the 28 lb. Weight for Distance, which Duane won with the throw of over 50 feet. Second was the 22 lb. Heavy Hammer, which Duane threw over 70 feet, both of these for 1st place. Making him "THE WESTERN CANADIAN CHAMPION IN THE AMATEUR B DIVISION" -Linda McClinton

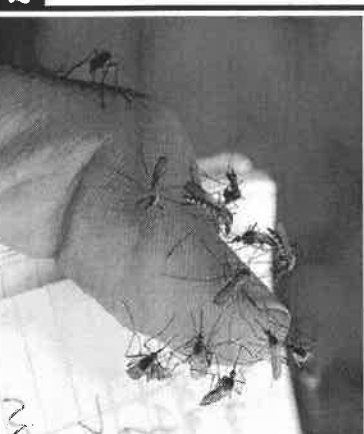
