

## POLICE REPORT

on January 17th, 2007 at 1141 PM McBride Detachment received a complaint of a stolen flat deck trailer with two snowmobiles attached, the unit was stolen from the parking lot of a local hotel. A McBride Detachment member was dispatched to the complaint and attended the parking lot where the member learned that the owner of the trailer headed westbound on Hwy. 16 in an attempt to locate his stolen trailer and sleds. At approximately 1:00 AM a McBride Detachment member attended the intersection of Hwy 16 and the Walker Creek FSR, there the officer met with the complainant who had just recovered his trailer, sleds, and a soon to be reported stolen 2002 Ford F350 Pickup truck stolen from Valemount. The Complainant advised that he had noticed a truck pulling a trailer with no light turn off of Hwy. 16 at the Walker Creek FSR, they decided to investigate and determined that the trailer and sleds belonged to him. The suspects continued to drive northbound on the Forest Service Road approximately 12 kilometres until they reached a dead end where the bridge had been removed. The two suspects fled into the bush and the complainant and friends recovered the property and drove it out onto the highway. A short time later addition units from Prince George, McBride, and the Police Dog and Handler arrived on scene. After a brief search of the area two adult male suspects from the City of Prince George were apprehended and transported back into Prince George to appear in Provincial Court on recommended charges of Possession of Stolen Property Over \$5,000. The estimated value of the property recovered is approximately \$40,000.
