**PUBLIC HEALTH**

**Kids: A Basic Ingredient for Fun Family Meals!** The time crunch of working parents, busy schedules and the overuse of convenience foods are challenges to cooking meals with our kids. In a survey of 4000 adult Canadians in 2006, only 4% said children helped them in the kitchen. How will kids learn to make and appreciate real food? With practice! A big part of the recipe for having fun family meals is parents bringing both boys and girls, into the kitchen to make meals together. With love and wholesome ingredients, kids will have fun making and learning about good food. Benefits to including kids in cooking are: 1) Increases kids comfort and knowledge around food - it may help with changing that dreaded picky eating behaviour! 2) It's a fun family activity! Pass along those treasured traditional/cultural memories of food and recipe favorites (borscht, stews, biscuit or ginger cookies). 3) Teaches important math, science and reading skills, patience, creativity and teamwork. 4) Improves nutrition intake (especially of vegetables and fruit) and teaches food safety habits like hand washing. If you have not done so already, cook together as a family this week. Here are some tips to make it pleasant: •Remember it will likely be messy but is another great chance for kids to learn the importance of cleaning up! •Make fun interactive foods like tacos, pizza, fruit or veggies with dip. •Choose simple recipes that are flexible enough to allow for some inaccurate counting and measuring and that help kids learn age appropriate skills. •Use wholesome, real foods from Canada's Food Guide in recipes, like carrots, peppers, cucumbers, chickpeas, kidney beans, eggs and whole grain breads. •Soap and rinse hands before working with food. For ideas about what to cook, try Secrets of Feeding a Healthy Family by Elynn Satter, Cooking with Children: 15 Lessons for Children Age 7 and Up, Who Really Want to Learn to Cook by Marion Cunningham or Kid's First Cookbook by the American Cancer Society. For more information, contact your local Community Nutrition Program. - Written by Flo Sheppard, Community Nutritionist, Northwest.
