Also, beware of outdated cake, brownie and cookie mixes. PASS IT ON!!!!

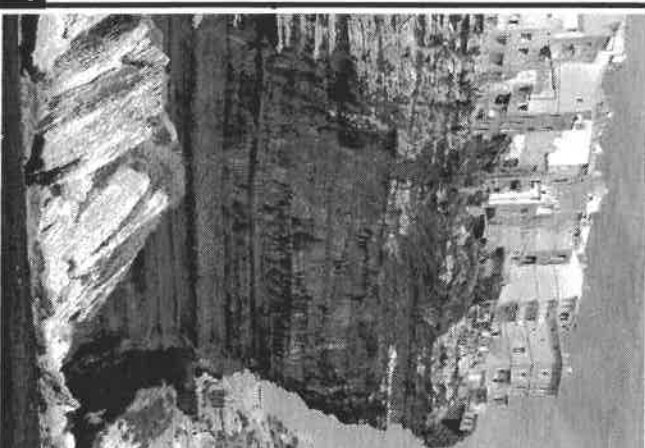
