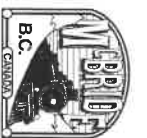

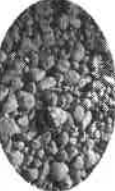

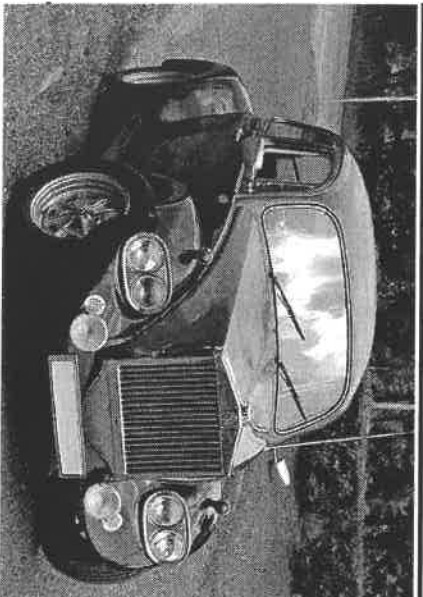

IS YOUR GARDEN DANGEROUS?

The long days of summer bring the joy of yardwork, camping and playing in the beautiful outdoors. Not too many people stop to think about the hidden dangers in dust and dirt.

Tetanus is a disease caused by a toxin released from a bacteria (Clostridium tetani). These bacteria have the ability to form spores (a protective capsule) which can live in the environment for many years in the dirt and dust! Spores can not be killed by boiling or by most disinfectants, therefore tetanus bacteria can never be eradicated from the environment.

Tetanus spores can get into your body when you an injury that punctures your skin..... no matter how minor. Once in your body the bacteria can release tetanus toxin which travels through the bloodstream to the spinal cord, blocking the activity of certain nerve cells. This leads to hyper stimulation of muscles causing extremely painful and potentially life threatening, uncontrollable muscle spasms. Tetanus is a severe disease and even with modern medical care the death rate is 10-20% from complications such as suffocation. Other complications include choking, difficulty eating, bone fractures, pneumonia, ulcers and lasting difficulties with speech, memory and mental function. In Canada, we are lucky that vaccination against tetanus is included in the regular immunizations that our children receive. Do you remember when YOUR last tetanus vaccine was? In Canada tetanus is extremely rare.... not because the bacteria and spores are gone BUT Canada's highly effective and safe immunization program. In B.C. infants receive tetanus vaccine as part of their regularly scheduled vaccines at 2-4-6-18 months of age. Children receive it again as part of their Kindergarten and grade nine vaccinations; adults should have a tetanus booster every ten years. The vaccine is safe, effective and free.

If you or your child is behind on this important vaccine, or if you have any questions please call your local public health unit or family doctor.
