## MEDIA RELEASE

**AIR QUALITY ADVISORY IN EFFECT - OPEN BURNING,  
WOOD BURNING, AND STREET AND PARKING LOT  
SWEEPING PROHIBITED.** The Ministry of Environment is

issuing an Air Quality Advisory for the Village of McBride and 15 km within the surrounding area of the Village due to expected short-term high levels of fine particulate matter. All residents and especially those who suffer from cardiac and respiratory diseases should be aware that particulate matter may cause adverse health effects. Open burning, including back yard burning and land clearing burning is banned during Air Quality Advisories. This advisory also prohibits recreational fires and street sweeping activities. Residents are also asked to suspend the use of wood burning appliances, except for Sole Wood Burning heat users. For information on the effects of air quality on persons with respiratory or cardiac illnesses please contact Northern Health at 565-2150 or visit the Northern Health website at [www.Northernhealth.ca](http://www.Northernhealth.ca) High levels of particulate matter are predominately due to the spontaneous combustion of a hog fuel pile. Light winds, dry conditions and clear skies over the area are expected to limit the dispersion of pollutants. This Air Quality Advisory is expected to be in effect until further notice.
