





LEVEL 1 FOOD SAFE COURSE? INTERESTED IN TAKING THE

The FOODSAFE Training Program teaches safe food handling procedures to students, workers, supervisors, and operators in the food services

industry.
FOODSAFE was developed cooperatively by FOODSAFE was developed cooperatively by government, business, health, safety, and education in British Columbia. It is also used across Canada and around the world.

FOODSAFE Level 1

The Level 1 course is for food service front-line workers such as bus persons, servers, dishwashers, and cooks.
Level 1 is usually delivered in a one day format (8 hours).
If you take this course in British Columbia and pass the final exam, you will be registered in the **BC Centre for Disease Control** database and you will receive a FOODSAFE certificate.

The Workers Compensation Board of British Columbia (WCB) and the FOODSAFE Steering Committee funded the 2002 revision of Level 1. The course includes worker safety as well as updated food safety.




