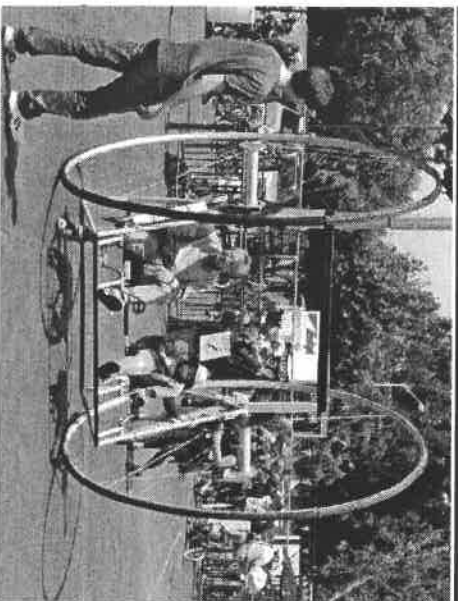

PIONEER DAYS

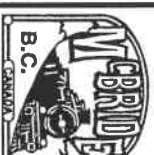

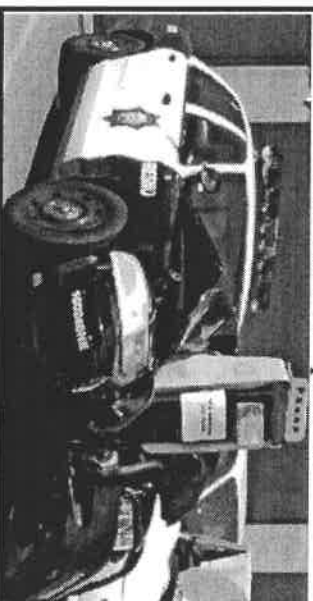
