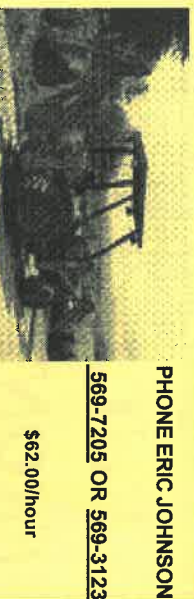

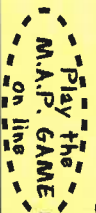

Car crashes are the leading cause of injury and death for children and youth in BC. The enhanced Motor Vehicle Act Regulations will help ensure that all children under 9 years are protected by an appropriate child car seat every time they ride in a car - no matter who is driving. Here is a summary of the new laws: • As of July 1st 2008, all drivers in BC (not just parents) must ensure that all children under 16 years are restrained appropriately for their age and weight. This includes drivers of rental vehicles, passenger vans and out of province vehicles. • The biggest news in the new law is that children over 18 kg (40 lbs) must use a booster seat up to their 9th birthday or reach 145 cm (4'9") in height. By using a booster seat, an adult seat belt can be positioned to protect a child in the event of a crash, reducing the risk of injury and death by up to 60%. • Children over one year AND 9 kg to 18 kg (20-40 lbs) must be secured in a forward-facing car seat. Forward-facing seats must be installed using the adult seatbelt or universal anchor system AND a tether strap. Some seats allow children to remain in the forward-facing seat beyond 18kg (40 lbs) so check the seats' manufacturers' instructions. • Infants must be in a rear-facing car seat until they are at least one year and weigh 9kg (20 lbs). Rear-facing seats must never be used in front of an active air bag. All child car seats must be used according to the manufacturer's instructions and vehicle owner's manual, and are safely in the back seat.
