VILLAGE OF MCBRIDE BURNING NOTICE

We would like to remind Village of McBride residents that Burning Permits are required for any type of burning, including recreational/camp fires.

The permit is **Free of Charge** and is available at the McBride Village Office during regular business hours.

Following are some important things to remember when burning:

- Fire pile is to be no larger than 8 cubic feet (2'x2'x2').
- No fire shall be left to burn at any time without a person of a least nineteen (19) years of age in attendance.
- A means of extinguishing the fire must be available.
- Fire must not be initiated if the local air flow will cause the smoke to negatively impact on a nearby population or cause Air Quality concerns.
- Avoid burning during windy conditions;

Please note that the Village of McBride does not permit any demolition burning or open grass burning. Open grass burning is only permitted for fire department training purposes.

A Burning Permit may be cancelled at any time by the Village of McBride, the Fire Chief or his designate.

If you have any questions in respect to burning, please contact the Village Office or the Fire Chief to ensure that you are in compliance with the bylaw.
