



## Subsidized, Senior Housing

By now, many of you will have heard of the proposed senior housing project for McBride. This provincial initiative answers our call to help needy seniors in our community. Due to the provincial election, we don't have a lot of information about the project.

Here is what we DO know:

- 1. The number of units: 10 units
- 2. Each one-level unit is 500-600 sq ft in size
- 3. BC lumber is being used for construction
- 4. The units will be managed by a Non-profit or a Society
- 5. The units are subsidized rental housing
- 6. The proposed rent may not exceed 30% of pension
- 7. All units to be wheel-chair accessible
- 8. The location has NOT yet been determined

We will provide more information, once it becomes available.

## Work in progress

Infrastructure remains the main focus of the Economic Development Office. Stable power and the 138 KV power lines tops the list of priorities.

Last month BC Hydro issued a second 'call' for clean energy. This 'call' is different as it contains a separate component specific to smaller communities such as McBride.

McBride Community Forest Corporation, EDO and Eco-PHASER are working together to present the case to BC Hydro.

We have also identified a manufacturing opportunity that can possibly create up-to 30 jobs over time and support our logging industry. Due to the Non-Disclosure Agreements we can't provide more information at this time.

Grants continue to be pursued, but the matching funds requirement limits our ability. We have to make difficult choices regarding which projects we invest in.

Over the next few months we will be updating out Economic Development Action Plan to reflect the global economic changes and completed projects.
