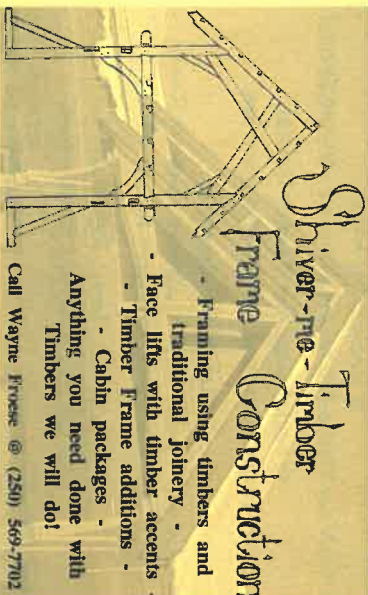

## Guide to Worm Composting

Going Green? Cathy Greenough will be at the McBride & District Public Library at 10am on Tuesday, May 26 to demonstrate how to set up and maintain your very own worm compost bin.

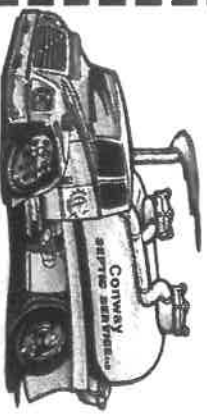
