**COMMUNITY NEWS**

Helping all children succeed for life - Success By 6@ is an early childhood development initiative, active in over 240 communities in BC. In the Canoe and Robson Valleys (Dome Creek to Alforda), they have just come through their first year and are preparing for their second. A community based partnership of individuals and organizations, committee members include representatives from the valley's health centres, daycares, support societies, educational system, aboriginal community, government ministries and literacy advocates; all share the common vision that children are ready to succeed when they enter school. Over the past year, they have funded training for early childhood professionals: two from Valemount Children's Activity Centre and three from Stepping Stones Daycare. Partnered with Columbia Basin Alliance for Literacy (CBAL) they co-hosted a free literacy workshop, last May. Together with CBAL and Columbia Basin Trust, they are now co-hosting a free Mother Goose@ Facilitator Teacher Training workshop (Oct. 31 and Nov. 1), to assist care-givers in language/literacy development. Info/ registration forms are available through contacts below. The goal of Success By 6@ is to build community capacity to support early childhood development services for children (0-6) and their families, to mobilize and leverage resources, to raise awareness of the importance of the early years and increase public support of early childhood development as a community priority. Funding requests must be through registered, non-profit societies; the next round of funding approvals will begin November 16, 2009. 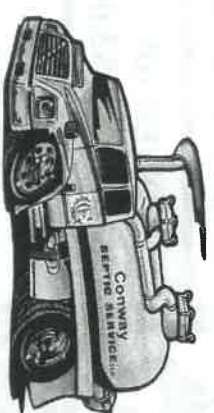

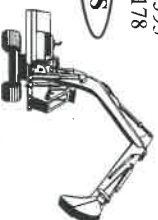

Whether you want a little more colour in your back yard, want to help wildlife, or are interested in increasing crop production in an environmentally-friendly manner, an up coming, free presentation, about native bees will fit the bill. Pollinators That Really Perform will be held Wednesday, October 21, at 7:00 pm at the North Country Lodge in McBride. The presentation, hosted by the Fish & Wildlife Compensation Program, highlights the importance of native bees to the world around us, and provides valuable tips on how to attract them to your back yard and keep them there. "When you mention bees, most people think of honey bees that were imported from Europe," says entomologist (insect biologist) and presenter Lynn Westcott. 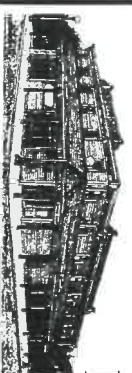
