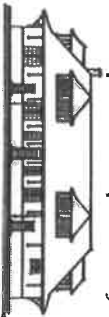

FLU CLINICS FOR THE HINI AND SEASONAL FLU OPEN TO ALL PUBLIC. Clinic Dates and Time for the Month of December: December 9: 10am-12 noon & 1-2 pm •December 10: 9am-12 noon •December 15: 1-3pm •December 17: 9am-12 noon. NEW RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHILDREN •All Children 6 months to <3 yrs. of age, and children with Chronic medical conditions aged 3-9 yrs. should receive two half-doses of the vaccine, 21 days apart. It is now recommended that healthy children aged 3-9 yrs. only receive 1 half-dose of the vaccine, and currently do not need to return for a second dosage. Check back in 3-4 weeks for updated dosing recommendations. If you have flu like symptoms, you are likely contagious for 24 hours before and 7 days after symptoms start. Stay home until you are completely symptom free (e.g.: no cough) or one week has past, whichever comes first. 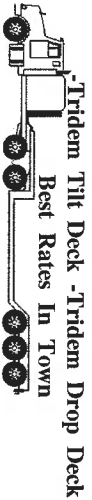

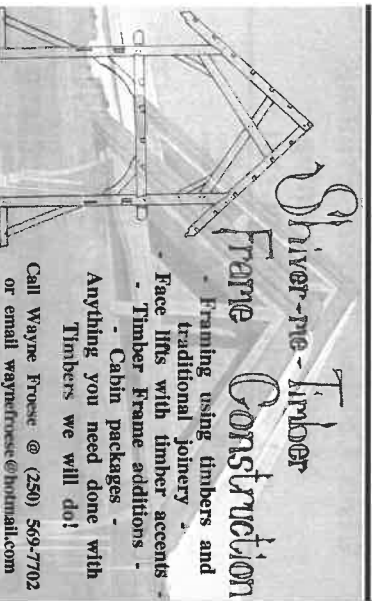

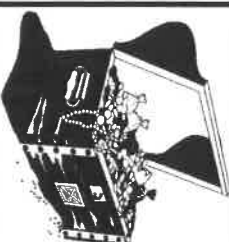
