

It is our hope that an organized, information packed approach assembled from the experiences of the entire community will make our case compelling and bring it to the forefront of those that have the ability to help.

In order to make this happen we really need your input and experiences. We are attaching a sheet for you to complete and return to us by January 31, 2010. We have already been gathering statistics on outages and feel the next step is to inform BC Hydro of the effects and costs so they fully understand the serious negative impact their deteriorating and unreliable power supply is having on our community.

The effects of a power outage can be as simple as no heat, light, water, phone, fax, internet, debit/credit card processing, fuel pumps, exhaust fans, ovens, cash registers and computers among other things. The cost of a power outage can be as complex as loss of business, lost sales, lost opportunity, profit and productivity. Missed deadlines, loss of reputation, lack of communication, spoilage, lost wages and increased expenses with the after effects on electronic equipment that must be replaced or repaired. It can also scare off potential expansions, new businesses investment and industries that rely on a stable power supply.

It is important that each of us take the time to be heard and we feel that this is an excellent opportunity to put our voices together. We thank you for taking the time to assist us in this effort and we look forward to adding your feedback and input to the report.
