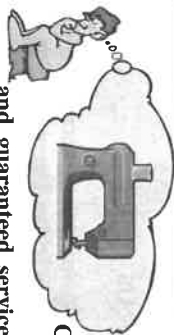

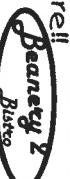

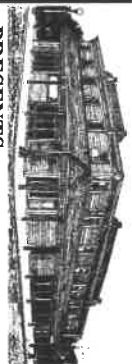

## SCHOOL NEWS

**MOVIE NITE FOR THE LOCAL FOOD BANK** - McBride Secondary will be hosting Movie Nite on Friday, December 3rd and all proceeds from the concession and the movie sales that night will go to the local food bank. We are also asking movie goers to bring a donation for the food bank to help out those that are less fortunate. Tickets are \$5.00 at Stedman's, McBride Trading Company Ltd., or at McBride Secondary and \$6.00 at the door. A concession is available.

The 4:30 movie is **DESPICABLE ME**, a compelling animated comedy. In a happy suburban neighbourhood surrounded by white picket fences with flowering rose bushes, sits a black house with a dead lawn. Unbeknownst to the neighbours, hidden beneath this home is a vast secret hideout. Surrounded by a small army of minions, we discover Gru (voiced by Steve Carell), planning the biggest heist in the history of the world. He is going to steal the moon (Yes, the moon!). In Universal's new feature, *Despicable Me*, Gru delights in all things wicked. Armed with his arsenal of shrink rays, freeze rays, and battle-ready vehicles for land and air, he vanquishes all who stand in his way. Until the day he encounters the immense will of three little orphaned girls who look at him and see something that no one else has ever seen: a potential Dad. The world's greatest villain has just met his greatest challenge: three little girls named Margo, Edith and Agnes. The movie is rated PG and is 95 minutes long.

The 7:00 movie is **THE SWITCH**. Kassie (Jennifer Aniston) is a professional woman in New York who has given up waiting for Mr. Right and starts looking for a sperm donor. This rather unsettles her best friend Wally (Jason Bateman), who has always had a crush on her but was afraid to tell her. When Kassie finds the perfect man (Patrick Wilson), her plan moves ahead, but Wally drunkenly makes a last-minute switch. Seven years later, Kassie returns to New York with her little boy (Thomas Robinson). Wally realizes what has happened, but he's even more afraid to break the news now. This romantic comedy is rated PG-13 and runs 1 hour 41 minutes.

## VILLAGE OF MCBRIDE Snow Removal

Reminder to our residents that it is once again snow removal season.

Please be patient during this time of year. The Village public works crew will be diligently working to keep our streets clear of snow.

Following are some points to remember during the snow season:

- Drive carefully and yield to snow removal equipment.
- Do not park vehicles on Main St. overnight.
- Avoid parking on streets when snow removal is in progress.
- Look for alternate routes where equipment is not working to access destinations.

Bylaw No. 568 Section 8 - Parking Regulations -

### Snow Removal

No Person shall park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain parked on any roads or lane way so as to interfere in any manner with the work of removing snow or ice there from or the clearing of snow there from.

Note that any unlicensed vehicles left unattended, parked on any road or lane way during a SNOW REMOVAL CONDITION, may be towed away and impounded at the OWNER'S EXPENSE.

Remember to drive carefully & follow winter driving rules. Your patience is appreciated during snow removal.
