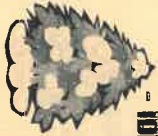

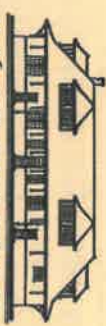

Chamber News

This week we are highlighting the chambers involvement with the McBride Community Development Visitor Service Centre, more commonly known as the Info Centre. Your Chamber partners with the Village of McBride and the Regional district in funding and overseeing the management of the Info Centre. The Info Centre benefits the business community in several ways, including directing tourist traffic into retail stores, accommodation and tourist activities. For example June through August of this year there were 10,500 visits to the centre only 435 of which were local residents. There were 5,900 requests for information. The most common requests were regarding accommodation, adventure recreation, local attractions, food and beverages and, interestingly, over 2,000 inquiries regarding shopping. These three months are the busiest, however Sept. Oct. April and May are close rivals. A Tourism, BC study shows that 83% of travellers who spoke with a councillor were more likely to return to the area and 90% were more likely to extend their stay. According to these studies there is substantial financial benefits to our community each year.

Look for more Chamber news updates in the coming weeks as we hope to shed some light on what we do to enhance our business community in front of and behind the scenes.

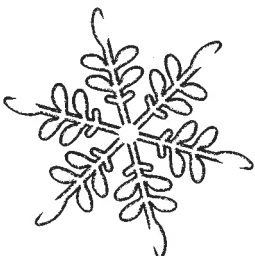
