**TAX FREEDOM DAY** - It is nearly impossible for ordinary Canadians to have a clear idea of how much tax they really pay. While we are painfully aware of sales taxes, calculating the total amount paid would require us to track all of our purchases over the course of a year. There are also many taxes of which Canadians are largely unaware because they are built into the price of goods and services. Such taxes include import duties, excise taxes on tobacco and alcohol, amusement taxes, and gas taxes. Many are unaware that they pay the employers' portion of payroll taxes such as Employment Insurance and Canada Pension Plans premiums and other taxes levied on businesses. Though businesses pay these taxes directly, the cost of business taxation is ultimately passed on to ordinary consumers. The Fraser Institute annually calculates Tax Freedom Day, which is the first day of the year in which a nation as a whole has theoretically earned enough income to fund its annual tax burden. In 2010, for Canada it was June 9, while in the US it was April 9.


