### SCHOOL NEWS

Dear McBride Community Members, The students and staff of McBride Centennial would like to invite you to join us in our "McBride Centennial Reads A Million Pages" Project and Fundraiser for the school year 2012-2013. Our goals are 1) to read, read, and read for the adventure and fun of it; 2) to raise funds for some projects at school; and 3) to say farewell to the Canadian penny which will no longer be minted as of February 2013. The funds raised will be used for new playground activities (30%), a school publishing project of students' writing (20%), an authors' visits (in person or by technology) (40%), and the local food bank (5%) and the Hospital Auxiliary (5%). We are aiming to raise a penny a page (the power of one 1+1+1...adds up).
