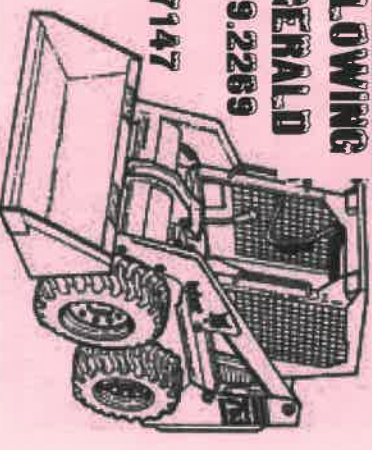

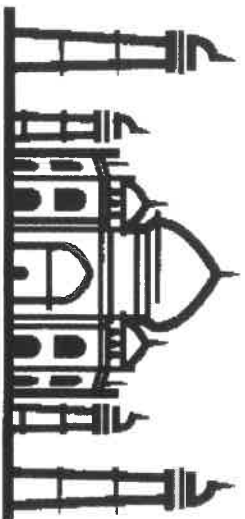

Public Review and Comment Forest Stewardship Plan Amendment #2
