Question: What is the basis of the fundraising goal of \$1,200,000?
Answer: This goal includes three basic costs:

- the 521 Main Street building (\$618,000);
- total renovation and set-up costs (\$381,400); and
- the 20% extra cushion required by most grants.

The purchase price is a fixed number. Renovation and set-up costs have been carefully estimated by knowledgeable volunteers and staff. These costs represent a building that is move-in ready (for both the museum and library), plus landscaping of the two extra lots.
