Cultural Centre Project Update

The library staff and trustees have, for several years, recognized the need for larger, more cohesive premises. The building committee has meticulously explored a series of options for expansion. When the opportunity to purchase 521 Main Street presented itself, all our projected needs were addressed in one stroke. The building can be used as it stands without major renovations (a carpeted floor would be nice). Regardless of the outcome of our efforts to acquire 521 Main, the expansion requirement is real and ongoing. **The library must relocate - this problem will not go away until it is solved.** Similarly, the museum needs a home. One hundred years have passed since the railway town of McBride was established, but there is still no secure storage for archival material, no adequate historical display space, no exhibit preparation facilities and no office. While the proposed space at 521 Main will require a series of upgrades over time, the accommodations can be occupied and utilized as they are prepared. **The museum must find a home - this problem will not go away until it is solved.** Fundraising - the next step - is now in full swing. Our immediate goal, the bottom line, is to find approximately \$620,000 and purchase the building by May 31, 2013. As you read this, trustees are contacting corporations and former residents of the valley. If you have questions, please ask a trustee or visit our friendly library staff. Watch for posters and flyers, and thank you so much for your interest, your questions, and your support.
