The Village of McBride has released a scare tactic letter that reveals worst case scenario for tax issues (tax exemption for library & museum) regarding the purchase of 521 Main Street for the new Cultural Centre; however that letter does not include the re introduction of the existing library & museum properties back into the tax base. We have been the largest tax payers and employer in the village and we cannot disagree with our Mayor without major consequences financially and personally, as well as creating negative impact in our community!
