HOCKEY NEWS

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself.
My name is Brady Knezeck and I am the new President of
McBride Minor Hockey (MMH) for the 2013/14 season.
My family and I moved to McBride in the summer of 2012.
I have coached and been involved in minor hockey executive
boards for the last 8 years. Like other associations, MMH
is experiencing the same issues with low registration numbers.
This season 26 players registered to play hockey from tykes
to midjet age players in McBride. MMH will only be able
to ice a home Bantam team this year. Ice times have been
slotted for all players however, some players and subsequently
their parents will have to commute to Valenmont if they want
to experience game situations. This situation had been the
focus of our executive board meetings this year. Equipment
costs, registration fees and tournament travel are all costly
parts of getting youth on the ice. I am a strong believer and
have seen first hand how important hockey can be in a
young persons life and for the community. Teamwork, a
sense of accomplishment, fitness, a safe place to be and most
of all FUN ... just to name a few. The MMH board is
exploring all options to help parents with the high cost of
outfitting a hockey player which include the acquisition of
new equipment for example skates and helmets to off-set
