**LIBRARY NEWS**

As a united group, the Library and Museum Trustees have come to the decision that we must re-examine our present goal of purchasing 521 Main Street. Our vision, built on input from the community, is still with us, but to this point we have not been able to raise sufficient funds within our tight timeframe. For at least 10 years it has been obvious to trustees and patrons that the present library and museum are inadequate. Other options were considered but did not meet our needs for space, accessibility, location, grounds or design. When the empty building at 521 Main Street first came to our attention, it seemed the perfect solution to our long-standing quest for an adequate library and museum facility. First and foremost, it is available at a fraction of the cost of a new building. Any alternative structure is likely to be more costly. When we started this project McBride was entering its Centennial year and centennial grants were available, however the timing was critical. Many months of delays and unforeseen hurdles prevented our taking advantage of Centennial year funding. We continue to research capital grants and creative funding opportunities, but this process takes time. We would like to thank Tom and Shelly Ryan for their patience with us. We feel it unfair to expect the Ryans to wait any longer for us to raise sufficient funds. If the building is available when we've raised the funds, we will be first in line as it remains an ideal location. We are not giving up! We remain committed to expansion, and are working hard to provide improved library and museum services for the Robson Valley. During the past year we have raised \$70,000 through individual donations and local community fundraisers! We are most grateful to the wider community for the support we have received. Our fundraising will continue as we look for other opportunities to provide a library and museum in the same vicinity. Thank you so much for your support throughout this journey. We invite your input as we move forward from here.

**MCBRIDE GRIZZLIES HOST TOURNAMENT**

The McBride Grizzlies Banham Hockey team hosted their home tournament last weekend at the Robson Valley Arena. Teams from 100-Mile House, Kamloops and Mackenzie competed in a 3 game round robin format with the 3rd and 4th place team playing on Sunday at 8am followed by the 1st and 2nd place teams playing at 10:30am. In the Grizzlies first game on Saturday they skated to a 10-2 win over the Kamloops Oilers with Dylan Vizza notching a hat-trick. This game also marked Shalyn Bratton's first point in hockey as she assisted on the Grizzlies 8th goal by Ryan Moore who had a strong game (2G - 1A) on defence. In game 2 the Grizzlies shut out 100-Mile House 8-0, defenseman Noah Jancke had a strong effort (2G - 1A). Dylan and Julie Vizza combined for 6 points in the game. In Game 3 against the Mackenzie Knights, Robert Knezczak played his strongest game of the tournament backs-topping the way to a 5-3 Grizzlies win. The score was not indicative of the play as Mackenzie had the Grizzlies bottled up in their end throughout the game. Grizzlies forward Bryden Basran elevated his play with 2 goals and 2 assists. On Sunday, the Kamloops Oilers claimed the 3rd place trophy with a convincing 14-1 victory over 100-Mile House. Center, Jarret Daoust led the way with 2 goals. In an excellent display of sportsmanship, Grizzlies center, part-time goalie and Valenmont resident, Eston Busin, stepped up and played goal for the 100-Mile House team who's regular goalie could not play in the tournament due to an injury. After tournament officials approved the move, Busin played 3 games for the 100-Mile House team much to the relief of the inexperienced non-goalie 100-Mile House had been forced to use. In the 1st place game after, the Grizzlies and Knights played each other for the 4th time this year. It was a fast paced, entertaining game that approx. 100 spectators were treated to. The game went back and forth with it being a 1-1 tie after the first period. After the second period the score was 3-2 for the Grizzlies. In the third period with the play going back and forth, Grizzlies forward Bryden Basran suffered a serious hip injury which knocked him out of the game. Basran was having a outstanding weekend with 6 goals and 7 assists. After Doctor's assessment, Grizzlies coaches have placed Basran on the 6 week injured reserve list. The Knights tied the game at 3-3 and applied pressure which resulted in the winning goal coming with less than 1 minute to play in the game. The Knights held on despite the Grizzlies pulling their goalie for an extra attacker and won the game 4-3. The Mackenzie Knights and Grizzlies coaches agreed after it was clean, fast paced game which brought out the best in both teams. The Knights returned the favor by winning the Grizzlies Home tourney something the Grizzlies had done to them in Mackenzie earlier in the season.
