INVITATION TO TENDER

Robson Centre Complex Painting

The Village of McBride invites tenders for the painting of the buildings in the Robson Centre Complex, 855 SW Frontage Road. The focus will be on the Liquor store and Post Office (400, 500) Cedar siding and window/door frames, and cedar siding touch ups and windows/door frames on Village Office Building (100, 200, 300) in the Village of McBride.

Scope of work includes the following:

- Cleaning - clean down and remove any loose foreign matter that causes neither undue damage to the substrate nor damage to, or contamination of, the surroundings or the paint system to be applied.
- Preparation of building including tapping trim, windows, doors.
- Glossy Surfaces - Adequately scuff and/or solvent or chemically etch as appropriate to provide satisfactory adhesion for subsequent paint coats.
- Application:
 - Two coats of painting on the trim of 9 windows, 4 doors, and 1 garage door and all cedar siding on Liquor store and Post Office Building.
 - Two coats of painting of the trim of 36 windows and 6 doors, and the touch up on cedar siding on the Village Office Building.
 - Drying - Unless otherwise specified, ensure that surfaces are cured and dry before applying additional coats of paint.
 - Wet Paint Warning - Place notices and do not remove until paint is dry.
 - Finish - Ensure each coat of paint is uniform in color, gloss, thickness and texture and free of runs, sags, blisters, or other discontinuities.
 - Clean up - Ensure that all areas are free from accumulations of waste materials before completing work.

The work is to be completed prior to September 15th, 2014 and references of previous painting installation experience and references must be provided.

Tender Documents will be available July 2nd, 2014. Tender Documents may be obtained from the McBride Village Office at 100 Robson Centre - 855 SW Frontage Road, McBride, BC, during regular business hours. The cost for each tender package is five dollars (\$5.00) (GST included) and is non-refundable.

A site meeting will be held on Thursday, July 10th, 2014 at 10:00 am at the McBride Village Office.

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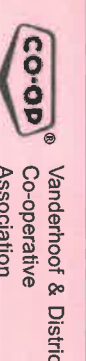

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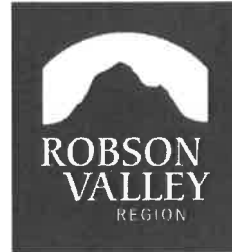
