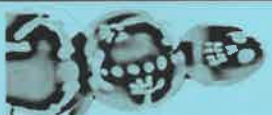

Written questions will be sorted by a committee of three. The committee will be looking for relevant, thoughtful content that are not personal attack questions but pertain to the betterment of the community. The committee may edit or restrict any questions that in their judgement are not appropriate.

The written questions will be given to the moderator and the moderator will direct the question to the applicable candidate(s).

Questions for the open microphone will be on a first come, first serve basis. The presenter must state their name and if they are representing an organization, that name as well.

Each presenter will have one minute to ask their question so the organizers recommend that you prepare your question beforehand. Candidates will have up to 2 minutes to answer. If time permits, there may be one rebuttal of 1 minute and the candidate will have another 2 minutes to reply to this.

The moderator will have absolute power to redirect or reject questions that have already been asked or otherwise deemed inappropriate.
