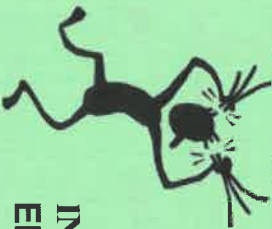

MCBRIDE GRIZZLIES NEWS

Grizzlies Place Fourth At Home Tourney - The McBride Grizzlies Midget Hockey Team hosted their home tournament on March 13, 14 and 15th. Eight teams participated in the very successful tourney. The Grizzlies would like to thank all members/parents of the association who volunteered in the concession and prize table. The Grizzlies started action off on Friday night with a game against the Prince George Steelworkers skating to an 8-1 victory. Bryden Basran led the way with 2 goals and 1 assist. Keith Shawara and Rylan Moore notched 2 goals each. Dylan Vizza and Darian Griffin also scored. Other assists in the game went to Brett Jones, Jordan Gibson, Dawson Drader, Hunter Friesen, Shaelyn Bratton, Dylan Vizza and Griffin. Grizzlies goaltender, Robert Knezacek, took the win. In Game 2 on Saturday morning, the Grizzlies took on the Kamloops Tropics. It was a fast-paced game which was tied 2-2 at the end of the second, when Kamloops came out strong in the third and skated to a 7-4 win. Grizzlies forward Brett Jones, who was moved to centre, responded with 2 goals. Bratton and Griffin also scored with assists coming from Billie Litcheild, Austin Gibson, Dylan Vizza, Friesen and Moore. Knezacek took the loss in net. In Game 3 the Grizzlies took on a familiar foe, the MacKenzie Knights started out fast with a 3-0 lead going into the second period. The Grizzlies responded half way through the second period when Dylan Vizza scored one of his eventual 3 goals (hat-trick) in the game. The Grizzlies came out flying in the third period scoring 6 goals with goalie Knezacek shutting the door onto a 7-4 win. Shawara pitched in with 2 goals with singles coming from Noah Jancke and Basran. Assists went to Shawara (3), Juliana Vizza and Dylan Vizza. This left the Grizzlies with a 2 wins 1 loss record. With Jasper and Kamloops having a strong tournament they were seeded one/two respectively for the championship game. The Grizzlies had to settle for the 3rd place game on Sunday against the MacKenzie Knights who had a similar record in round robin.
