





A community meeting was held last Thursday, November 26 to discuss the community capacity and resources required to consider hosting Syrian refugee families in the McBride community. The session was attended by over 30 interested community members and the notes of the session will be made available shortly. The focus of the meeting was on community capacity and also included information on how individuals and groups could become actively involved in sponsoring Syrian refugees. Participants felt that the majority of the gaps identified could be overcome by everyone working together and that we are a welcoming community that would step up to the plate to help. There is a lot of work to be completed if a Group of 5 (G%) or more were to become a sponsor - including a financial commitment. Additional work is being considered regarding pairing up with a Sponsorship Agreement Holder (SAR), looking at raising the necessary funds to sponsor families and getting a financial and support commitment from individuals to move forward. 
