### McBride Syrian Refugee Private Sponsorship Drive Group of Five (G5) or Community Sponsor (CS)

An information meeting was held in McBride on November 26, 2015 to provide private sponsorship information and gauge community support regarding sponsorship. At that meeting there was sufficient interest in gathering a group of individuals together to create a new life in Canada for a Syrian family. Moving forward, we are gathering support from as many community members as we can to achieve that goal. If you are able to help in any way, please consider providing that information and returning this form in person to the Robson Valley Support Society or mail to Rick Thompson Box 954 McBride, BC on or before January 31, 2016.

### **Additional information**

In order to sponsor a refugee, a Group of Five (G5) Canadians or Community Sponsors (CSs) need to demonstrate that they have in place the necessary funds or in-kind resources to support a family for 12 months from their arrival and settlement. The estimated settlement costs (financial and in-kind) for a family of 6 (two adults and four children) is \$32,000.00.

Once a Group of Five (G5) or Community Sponsors (CSs) has demonstrated that they have the resources in place to support a refugee family, then they can complete a sponsorship application (Settlement Plan and Financial Assessment). This is best done by working with existing Sponsorship Agreement Holders (SAHs).

Once approved as a Group of Five (G5) or Community Sponsors (CSs), the group can apply for a Refugee Profile to find the best fit for our community.

### **Next Steps**

We plan to gather support and commitment from community members through this mail out.

Once completed, we will communicate with everyone that has completed support forms regarding the outcome of our support drive. With a positive response we will;

- Open a bank account at the Scotia Bank to receive cash donations
- Arrange for collection and storage of in-kind donations
- Coordinate with volunteers
- Complete the necessary paperwork with the Federal government and begin work with a SAH to identify a family

### What are other Communities doing to support refugees?

In addition to McBride and area, there is a group working on sponsoring a family in Valemount and another group doing the same in Jasper, Alberta. Prince George has a number of groups working to bring several families to that community – in fact they just welcomed their first family in January. This means that there will be a good network of support for our new Canadians in our area.
