Message to McBride:

Yeah or Nay on the "Robson Valley Exploration and Learning Centre"? When I received the information pamphlets recently from the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George it triggered old memories from the summer & winter of '80-81. Jean & I were employed by the BC government to provide dental services to small towns around the province that were designated as 'underserviced', vis-à-vis dentists. We had the pleasure of serving twice, once over the summer, then later that winter in The Village of McBride. Our initial set-up was in what is currently known as the annex, adjacent to the library, but was then the health unit. The BC government provided the equipment while we supplied the services. I recall with great horror then how our suction unit, which was water cooled, leaked, no amend that, poured water onto the floor of the rear-most section of the health unit. We tried to stop the copious quantities of water, but nothing seemed to work. It just couldn't be fixed properly! I kept thinking, 'imagine the rot that's going to result from this!' Fast forward to today and I think we can all understand that these buildings are barely adequate for their purposes, and the likelihood of repair would seem like spending good money after bad. So what to do? The Robson Valley has been in an economic slump for many years, despite the work of many of its dedicated residents to turn it around, and Alberta's oil and gas industries no longer offer the once abundant job opportunities. Times are tough, jobs are scarce, and optimism is waning. The easiest thing would be to say the hell with it. We've got a library, we've got a museum, let it ride. Keep the status quo. We don't need any further taxation now! But I am writing this piece for a different reason. I believe in McBride. I believe in the Robson Valley. Ok, I hear it now-he buggered off. True, but I still believe. McBride deep down has always had what I refer to as resiliency-it takes a lickin' but stands up again and sees a better way. Look at the wonderful schools, the fabu



LIBRARY QUESTION

Question of the Week: How Much Will My Taxes Increase if the Purchase of 521 Main Street goes ahead? There seems to be some misinformation about tax impacts of the proposed Robson Valley Exploration and Learning Service. As described in the Regional District of Fraser Fort George bulletin of March 24, 2016, the residential tax levy would be \$27.47 based on a \$100,000 assessment. To calculate your tax impact, divide the assessed value of your residential property by 100,000 and multiply the result by \$27.47. For example, if your assessed value is \$140,000, then 140,000 divided by 100,000 = 1.4 x \$27.47 = \$38.45 (total annual tax impact) or \$3.20/month. If your assessed residential value is \$200,000, then it would mean an increase of \$54.94/year or \$4.58/month. The business levy would be \$67.30 per \$100,000 assessed value. If your business levy would mean an increase of \$94.22/year or \$7.85/month. If your assessed business value is \$200,000, then it would mean an increase of \$134.60/year or \$11.22/month.
