THE COMMUNITY MARKET

Dates: Fridays, in the Pavilion at Main and 2nd, McBride, June 24 through September 2 from 11am to 2pm. Please note the change in service hours this year.

The Community Market held its 2016 meeting on May 12. The Market is a loose association of independent vendors who operate under the umbrella of the Market's business licence. The Market itself is non-profit and donates funds, above operating costs, to local organizations.

The Community Market rules are few and simple:
Featured are locally grown, created or assembled goods for sale by Valley residents from Dome Creek to Dunster. All vendors who meet these criteria are welcome to take part in the Market. The cost is \$5 per individual table per week. Sales must not begin before 11am.

Foods on the "restricted" Food Safe list may not be sold. Those selling foods on the "high risk" foods list must possess a Food Safe Certificate, plus Certification from Northern Health. Vendors will be asked to show these papers.

Buskers are welcome to perform near, but not inside, the Market, and only acoustic instruments are permitted, with no electronic assistance.





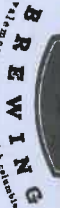
