Community Meeting: The McBride Centennial and McBride Secondary School Parent Advisory Committees (PACs) are jointly hosting a public community meeting to address very important issues facing our schools and students and the community at large. School District 57 has postponed co-location. The PACs feel this is still on the table for the next few years. What are the ramifications for students, teachers and our community if co-location goes ahead in the next few years? How would SD57 ensure that a K-12 school would meet the needs of all students? Is closing the elementary school actually cost-effective? What are the rationalizations for this plan? Is the time-line for co-location workable? What will happen with the elementary school and property should it be closed?

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 22 - 6:00pm. at the Roundhouse Theatre. A significant challenge currently facing our high school students, given current low enrolment, is reduced course offerings in front of teachers. Reduced course options will soon mean that high school students in McBride may not be able to take the courses they need from a teacher in McBride to enter post-secondary programs or even graduate! Co-location will not solve this serious problem. How will SD57 ensure that our students can graduate in McBride and complete the courses they need - in front of teachers - in their own school in order to enter the work force and post-secondary programs? The PACs have invited all SD57 Trustees and senior administrative staff from Prince George to the community meeting to answer questions and provide insight into these important issues. We would like to be able to work openly and collaboratively with SD57 on issues facing our schools: if you are a parent, a grandparent, business owner, student, Robson Valley resident....please come to the meeting and have your voice heard!
