THE COMMUNITY MARKET

The Market started Friday, June 23 and will be held every Friday from 11am to 2pm until September 1, in the Pavilion at Steve Koldia park. The cost per table remains at \$5 each week. This year we are pleased to announce Marion Cousineau will be providing hot lunch services during the Market. The Community Market is a loose association of independent vendors who operate under the umbrella of the Market's business license and the rules are few and simple. Goods must be grown, made or assembled in the Valley by Valley residents from Dome Creek to Dunster. Northern Health rules apply to all foodstuffs sold at the Market. Foods on the "high risk" list may not be sold. Vendors may be asked to present their certificates. Vendors are required to stay until their goods are all sold or until 2pm, whichever comes first. Customers coming to the Pavilion and seeing empty spaces or vendors packing up early may not return. Therefore leaving early is unfair to the rest of the vendors and detrimental to the Market operation. Buskers are welcome to perform outside the Pavilion, but only acoustic instruments are permitted. No electronic assists. Five vendors have already booked their table spaces for the entire year. Other table spaces are assigned on a first come first served basis.
