

Building Inspection - Call Us Before You Start!

The McBride building inspection office has moved into the Robson Valley Community Centre at 4411 Columbia Street.

The goal of the Building Inspection department is to ensure the health, safety and protection of persons and property by confirming that buildings and their systems generally conform to relevant bylaws, the B.C. Building Code and other applicable standards.

But before you start building, check with the Regional District. Planning staff can check on the zoning for your area, service centre staff can provide a list of requirements for your project and refer you to other agencies where necessary. And our building inspectors can help answer your technical questions.

Building Inspectors provide interim spot checks on the construction stages in accordance with the BC Building Code and building plans that have been submitted for a permit. A permit is required for construction, alteration, repair or demolition of a building or structure, building relocations, masonry fireplaces and solid fuel burning appliances and chimneys, as well as, plumbing systems.

The Regional District of Fraser-Fort George provides a building inspection service within its electoral areas and by contract to the Village of McBride.
